

Message from the

Executive Director

Dear Festival Attendees,

Welcome to the 15th Greenfield Youth Film Festival! I am assuming that many of you are here for the first time and I hope that you enjoy the experience. This is the first time we are doing it live since 2019. While I am one of those people who loves being home in my sweats watching something on the sofa, this event is so much better in person because it gets the students excited to see if they've won and, even if they haven't, they will enjoy watching what others have done and hopefully that will motivate them to do something even bigger and better next time.

The Festival began when my late husband, Ron, and I sat down with members of the Upper Dublin School District, the Township of Upper Dublin, and other community members and asked what they would do if given a \$100,000 grant from the Greenfield Foundation. A lot of brainstorming was done and we eventually came up with a film festival that started with 5 local high schools. Every year the number of schools changes slightly but is usually around twenty. In the fall we hold a full-day workshop at which professional filmmakers teach lighting, sound design, storytelling, scriptwriting, etc. in hopes that the students will use the skills they acquire to make their films. This year there were 175 films submitted and they were all watched by 2-6 judges so we could choose which ones would be shown tonight.

I wish that we could show more films but time is limited so we are only showing/giving out 20 awards. I try to keep the comments by the presenters brief so that you can see more of the student films. The Festival is a large undertaking that requires so many people and organizations. The event is possible through a collaboration between the Greenfield Foundation, the Upper Dublin Education Foundation, and the School District of Upper Dublin. Without the support of every member of each of those boards, the Festival could not occur. And thanks to the Festival Team (Abby, Bryn, Dave, David, Jason, and Henry), the Upper Dublin maintenance staff, the mentors, the judges, the students and the parents, we put together this great event with wonderful films. I hope that you enjoy your evening and if you have any suggestions for the Festival, I am always happy to get feedback.

Carly Jennion — Carly is a West Coast Page in the NBCUniversal Page Program, a highly competitive early career development program that has a 1.5% acceptance rate. In her time as a Page, she moved to Los Angeles and has worked on various shows and movies from NBC and Universal. Carly's narrative film won 1st place at the 2018 Greenfield Youth Film Festival.

Karin Kelly – Karin is an indpendent filmmaker who received her M.F.A. in Film from N.Y.U. She was a fellow for Warner Bros. and Paramount Pictures, participated in the Sundance Institute Screenwriters Intensive and is a recipient of the prestigious Princess Grace Foundation Grant. She is the co-author of Film School Confidential: The Insider's Guide to Film Schools. Her narrative short, Cinco Meses, is now on the festival circuit, and she just completed production on her latest film, L'Inverno. When not making her own films, she instructs students on how to make theirs as the Department Head of Cinema & Television at Drexel University.

Dave Lamm – Dave has been in the film and video world for over 20 years. He loves what he does, and he always enjoy sharing his knowledge of his craft to others.
