



U P P E R D U B L I N MEDALS PROGRAM

Criteria for Upper Dublin Medal Awards Candidates

Outstanding Citizen

The Selection Committee recognizes **an individual for exemplary service** to the Upper Dublin community, including charitable work, volunteering, long-term involvement, or other significant achievements that have made a lasting impact. While recipients are typically Upper Dublin residents, non-residents with a sustained record of service within the township may also be considered.

Exclusions:

- *Individuals currently serving in elected or appointed public positions are not eligible.*
- *Current or former employees of any program partner may only be considered for service beyond their professional duties.*

Outstanding Educator

The Selection Committee recognizes **a full-time teacher or administrator** currently employed by the Upper Dublin School District who has made significant contributions to education. The nominee should demonstrate:

- A commitment to motivating and inspiring students toward academic achievement.
- Exceptional professional expertise and a dedication to sharing knowledge, ideas, and talents.
- Active engagement in both the school district and broader community.

Outstanding Community Business or Non-Profit Organization

The Selection Committee recognizes a **business or non-profit organization** that has made a substantial impact on the Upper Dublin community. Contributions may include:

- Enhancing educational opportunities for Upper Dublin students.
- Improving the quality of life for local residents.
- Long-term service and/or a significant recent community service project that benefited Upper Dublin.

Exclusions:

- *Elected or appointed boards/groups affiliated with program partners are not eligible.*

Student Leadership Awards - Nominated by Upper Dublin High School staff, these awards are presented to two members of the Upper Dublin High School senior class who have displayed outstanding leadership qualities in the classroom (academics) and through their involvement in athletics, music, drama, or other school and community activities. In the area of academics, the students have maintained superior grades, intellectual curiosity, and exceeded teacher expectations. In the area of athletics or activities, the students have each participated in a minimum of one activity and have demonstrated character, leadership, service and/or a commitment to excellence. The students have established themselves as positive role models in the school and community through these endeavors.

Please note: Previous medal winners are not eligible for a nomination in the same category in which they were honored
